- The Year Overall: \$2,300 in the black (nearly a 5% profit)

 - Bob would like to wait to see if there will be any increases in postage, printing, etc.
 - Proposal to keep rates the same, to share calendar for advertisers to see when events
 are happening and when ads are due (so that they advertise), and to begin a Spring
 Fling.
 - April issue to be Spring Fling any advertiser in January, February, or March, they get 50% off a coupon. If a business only wants to advertise in Spring Fling, the cost will be \$50-60 for production.
