 - The remaining funds include new commercial, additions to commercial, and additions to residential
 - Citizen's Academy
 - Opportunity for those who are interested in municipal government. It will be a sixweek course. Those in attendance will receive a graduation ticket.
 - Off-Street Trail
 - Being created from Bode to YMCA to Velp Ave.
 - 29/VV Interchange
 - Acquisition for project is complete
 - \$23 million
