Individuals who are 17 years of age in most states (16 with parental consent where allowed by state law), weigh at least 110 pounds and are in generally good health may be eligible to donate blood.

High school students and other donors 18 years of age and younger also have to meet certain height and weight requirements.

Watch out for tax scammers

Sadly, identity theft happens throughout the year – but some identity thieves are particularly active during tax-filing season. How can you protect yourself?

One of the most important moves you can make is to be suspicious of requests by people or entities claiming to be from the Internal Revenue Service. You may receive phone calls, texts and emails,

but these types of communication are often just "phishing" scams with one goal in mind: to capture your personal information. These phishers can be quite clever,

sending emails that appear to contain the IRS logo or making calls that may even seem to be coming from the IRS. Don't open any links or attachments to the emails and don't answer the calls – and don't be alarmed if the caller leaves a vaguely threatening voicemail, either asking for personal information, such as

your Social Security number, or informing you of some debts you supposedly owe to the IRS that must be taken care of "immediately."

In reality, the IRS will not initiate contact with you by phone, email, text message or social media to request personal or financial information, or to inquire about issues pertaining to your tax returns. Instead, the agency will first send you a letter. And if you're unsure of the legitimacy of such a letter, contact the IRS directly at

800-829-1040.

Of course, not all scam artists are fake IRS representatives – some will pass themselves off as tax preparers. Fortunately, most tax preparers are honest, but it's not too hard to find the dishonest ones who might ask you to sign a blank return, promise you a big refund before looking at your records or try to charge a fee based on the percentage of your return.

HSBPA accepting applications for scholarships

The Howard-Suamico Business & Professional Association would like to provide financial support in the form of a scholarship to several graduating seniors from Bay Port High School who intend to pursue a four-year or technical college degree.

Student Qualifications

4-Year Degree College Scholarship

- The student must be seeking a post-secondary degree at a four-year college or university
- The student must be admitted to a college or university
- The student must have a minimum 3.00 grade point average at Bay Port High School

The student must have demonstrated leadership qualities through participation in academic areas as well as extracurricular activities while attending Bay Port High School.

This scholarship will be awarded after the completion of the first semester of classes as a full-time student at a college or university of choice with the recipient having a grade point average of at least 2.75. Recipient must redeem award within two years from date of high school graduation.

Technical College Scholarship

- The student must be seeking a post-secondary degree at a technical college
- The student must be admitted to a program at a technical college
- The student must have a minimum 2.50 grade point average at Bay Port High School



This scholarship will be awarded after the completion of the first semester of classes as a full-time student at a technical college of choice with the recipient having a grade point average of at least 2.50. Recipient must redeem award within two years from date of high school graduation.

Application Process

To apply for a HSBPA Scholarship, a student should download either the HSBPA 4-Year College Degree Application or the HSBPA Technical College Scholarship Application at www.hsbpa.org/scholarship. Specific application directions are on the informational page of the application.

Selection Process

Scholarship applicants will be reviewed by the Community Service Committee of the HSBPA. Recommendations will be solicited from the counselors at Bay Port High School. The recommendation of the Community Service Committee will be presented to the HSBPA Board of Directors to be voted upon. Any recommendation made by the committee must receive a majority vote to be considered valid.

South landfill ready for January opening

After many years of planning and two years of construction, Brown County's South Landfill is ready to begin accepting waste starting January 31, on schedule despite some supply chain issues. The past few months have focused on completing construction of the maintenance building and leachate tank, equipment acquisition and hiring and training staff to operate the landfill.

When operations begin at the South Landfill in the town of Holland, only residential waste from Brown and Winnebago counties will be accepted for the first month. That's to create a 4-foot fluff layer to act as a protective barrier for the synthetic liner in the landfill cell. Once the fluff layer is complete, the landfill will be able to accept all trash including building, commercial and industrial waste.

The synthetic liner is key to the leachate collection system that is required to protect the groundwater. Any moisture that collects in the landfill cell is considered leachate that must be treated through a wastewater treatment plant. The landfill is designed so that leachate moves toward the northeast corner of the landfill cell where it's pumped into the leachate tank, then hauled off site for treatment at NEW Water, the brand of the Green Bay Metropolitan Sewerage District.

In addition to the landfill cell and leachate system, the South Landfill also includes an area for residents to deposit recyclable material. The residential drop-off area includes dumpsters and bunkers for collection of materials like concrete, tires, appliances, shingles, scrap metal and brush – materials that may be recycled. The landfill and the residential drop-off area will not be able to accept electronics and hazardous waste. That material must continue to be taken to the Hazardous Material Recovery Facility at 2561 S. Broadway in Ashwaubenon.

The Brown County South Landfill will open January 31 as the existing Outagamie County landfill nears capacity. A new landfill cell in Outagamie County is also under construction and when completed in 2024 will operate in tandem with the Brown County landfill serving residents and businesses in Brown, Outagamie and Winnebago counties as part of the BOW partnership.

Legitimate tax preparers will make no grand promises and will explain their fees upfront. Before hiring someone to do your taxes, find out their qualifications. The IRS provides some valuable tips for choosing a reputable tax preparer, but you can also ask your friends and relatives for referrals.

Another tax scam to watch out for is the fraudulent tax return – that is, someone fil-

ing a return in your name. To do so, a scammer would need your name, birthdate and Social Security number.

If you're already providing two of these pieces of information – your name and birthdate on social media, and you also include your birthplace – you could be making it easier for scam artists to somehow get the third. It's a good idea to check your privacy settings

and limit what you're sharing publicly.

You might also want to use a nickname and omit your last name, birthday and birthplace.

Here's one more defensive measure: File your taxes as soon as you can. Identity thieves often strike early in the tax season, so they can file their bogus returns before their victims.

To learn more about tax

scams, visit the IRS website at [irs.gov](https://www.irs.gov) and search for the "Taxpayer Guide to Identity Theft." This document describes some signs of identity theft and provides tips for what to do if you are victimized.

The second smaller rink has no boards or fencing and is intended for general use. Both rinks have lights for night time use.

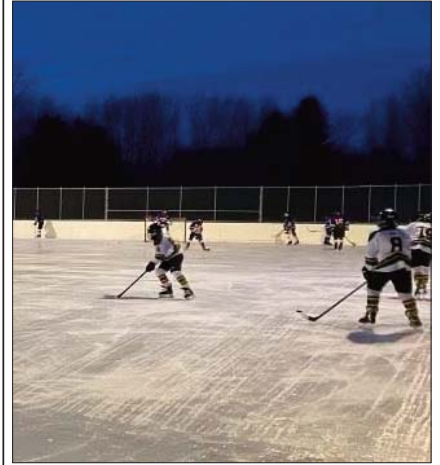
The warming shelter at the
