Did you know? Your home contains hazardous materials

You may not realize it, but hazardous and poisonous materials are common in most households. We use them to clean, remodel, repair and even repel rodents or insects. Chances are, you don't think much about it. But how we

store and dispose of these materials is key to keeping our families, pets and environment safe. For National Poison Prevention Week, March 20-26, Brown County Resource Recovery is here to help you know what to do with those items before you throw them away.

Household items such as cleaners, bleach, paint, pesti-

cides and even gasoline are all considered hazardous materials. These should be kept away from children and pets to prevent accidental poisonings. Lock them in cabinets that can't be easily accessed.

When it's time for disposal, don't toss them in your garbage or pour down the drain. They can easily contaminate soils and water caus-

ing harm to the public and environment. The disposal solution is pretty simple: take them to the Hazardous Material Recovery facility for proper disposal.

Medications and sharps are

Let's work together to reduce accidental poisonings as well as contamination of our environment. The HMR facility makes it easy and convenient to drop-off these materials. You'll feel good knowing you are doing the right thing for people, pets and our planet. HSBPA accepting applications for scholarships



The Howard-Suamico Business & Professional Association would like to provide financial support in the form of a scholarship to several graduating seniors from Bay Port High School who

intend to pursue a four-year or technical college degree.

Student Qualifications

4 - Year Degree College Scholarship

- The student must be seeking a post-secondary degree at a four-year college or university
- The student must be admitted to a college or university
- The student must have a minimum 3.00 grade point average at Bay Port High School

The student must have demonstrated leadership qualities through participation in academic areas as well as extracurricular activities while attending Bay Port High School.

This scholarship will be awarded after the completion of the first semester of classes as a full-time student at a college or university of choice with the recipient having a grade point average

of at least 2.75. Recipient must redeem award within two years from date of high school graduation.

Technical College Scholarship

- The student must be seeking a post-secondary degree at a technical college
- The student must be admitted to a program at a technical college
- The student must have a minimum 2.50 grade point average at Bay Port High School

This scholarship will be awarded after the completion of the first semester of classes as a full-time student at a technical college of

choice with the recipient having a grade point average of at least 2.50. Recipient must redeem award within two years from date of high school graduation.

Application Process

To apply for a HSBPA Scholarship, a student should download either the HSBPA 4-Year College Degree Application or the HSBPA Technical College Scholarship Application at www.hsbpa.org/scholarship. Specific application directions are on the informational page of the application.

Selection Process

Scholarship applicants will be reviewed by the Community Service Committee of the HSBPA. Recommendations will be solicited from the counselors at Bay Port High School. The recommendation of the Community Service Committee will be presented to the HSBPA Board of Directors to be voted upon. Any recommendation made by the committee must receive a majority vote to be considered valid.

Shipping returns to the Port of Green Bay

The winner of the annual First Ship Contest is revealed



The Michigan – Great Lakes kicked off the shipping season at the Port of Green Bay on Friday, March 18 at 1:00 p.m.

The first shipment of cargo for the 2022 shipping season made it's way into the Port of Green Bay on Friday, March 18 at 1:00 p.m. The Michigan – Great Lakes (tug and barge) kicked off the shipping season with a delivery of petroleum products to US Venture. The arrival of the Michigan – Great Lakes marks the end to the annual First Ship Contest put on by the Port of Green Bay and hosted by Discover Green Bay.

"Certainly the weather has cooperated and we are off to a relatively early return to shipping for the Port and the Great Lakes," said Dean Haen, Port Director. "After reaching close to 2 million tons of cargo last shipping season, we are cautiously op-

timistic about strong cargo movement this year."

The Port of Green Bay and Discover Green Bay began accepting guesses for the first ship's arrival through its annual First Ship Contest a month ago. This year's winner is Ellen Buhrmann of Merrill, Wisconsin whose guess was right on target at 1:00 p.m. on March 18. The prize package includes a \$100 Green Bay Sail & Paddle gift certificate, a one-night stay at the Hampton Inn Green Bay Downtown, a \$50 gift card from The Depot Green Bay, a 2022 Snapshots of Light Calendar by Chuck Zentmeyer, a 200th Anniversary Brown County Monopoly game and a Port of Green Bay swag bag.

"It was great to again see a lot of interest in the First Ship Contest with more than 210 entries," Haen added. "That really shows that there is interest and understanding of the important role that shipping plays for our regional economy."

Anyone interested in shipping is encouraged to view the ships from the Fox River Trail, the Green Bay Metro Boat Launch or other areas along the Lower Fox River. Port security requirements do not allow public access on any port property.

Tecmo Super Bowl National Championship returns to The Watering Hole

On Saturday, April 9th, The Watering Hole will host the Tecmo Super Bowl National Championship, Tundra Bowl IX presented by Game Trade. Last year, nearly 80 players from 15 different states competed to win over \$5,000 of cash and prizes. Oshkosh's own Josh Aaronson took home first prize last year.

Tundra Bowl continues its partnership with My Brother's Keeper as Harry Sydney, an in-game Tecmo Super Bowl player for the San Francisco 49ers and three-time Super Bowl Champion, will be on-hand to sign autographs at the event. In the last three years of the partnership, over \$1,700 has gone towards providing resources and mentoring for boys and men in Brown County and the surrounding areas through MBK.

Tundra Bowl was started in 2014 by Howard native

Nate Smithson and Algoma native Brian Swagel. Tecmo Super Bowl was the first 11-on-11 NFL licensed football game, and was released in December of 1991 for the Nintendo Entertainment System. Tundra Bowl features games being played on all original Nintendo hardware and tube TVs to recreate the authentic retro experience.

Smithson, the Tundra Bowl Director, stated "Last year, we had a phenomenal turnout, and raised a significant amount of money for My Brother's Keeper and Children's Hospital of Wisconsin. We have a Division 1 and Division 2 setup so that less-experienced or casual players can come out and enjoy playing the game a lot of us grew up on. We'd love to see the local community turn out strong this year."

Tundra Bowl Weekend also includes two Friday night events - Tecmo: Twist

of Fate, and a 2v2 tournament. They will also have other games on tap from Nintendo, Super Nintendo, Sega Genesis, and other video game consoles to play. The cost to play in the tournament varies based on the division the players wish to play in. Paid registrations for either division on Saturday includes a Tundra Bowl shirt, and free

entry into the drawing for door prizes. In addition to cash prizes for the top finishers of Division 1 and a number of NFL and other prizes for Division 2's top finishers, Tundra Bowl is giving away autographed NFL memorabilia, signed jerseys, Green Bay Packers items, and other unique prizes.

Each player that plays in

Tundra Bowl IX is guaranteed a number of games against other players, and both divisions will include a Tournament Bracket after group play for top finishers. Doors open at 10:00 a.m., and the tournament starts at 11:00 a.m. at The Watering

Blood is a perishable product that can only come from generous volunteers. By do-

minating blood, individuals can make a difference in the lives of patients in their community and throughout the nation.

To make an appointment or to learn more, download the American Red Cross Blood Donor app, visit redcrossblood.org or call 1-800-RED CROSS (1-800-733-2767).

Completion of a RapidPass online health history questionnaire found at redcrossblood.org/rapidpass is encouraged to help speed up the donation process.

A blood donor card or driver's license or two other forms of identification are required at check-in.

Individuals who are 17

years of age in most states (16 with parental consent where allowed by state law), weigh at least 110 pounds and are in generally good health may be eligible to donate blood.

High school students and other donors 18 years of age and younger also have to meet certain height and weight requirements.
